

Website Privacy Policy

Ezek Consultancy Limited understands that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how your information is used and shared online. We respect and value the privacy of everyone who visits Our Site and will only collect and use information in ways that are useful to you and in a manner consistent with your rights and Our obligations under the law.

This Policy applies to Our use of any and all data collected by us in relation to your use of Our Site or information submitted through Our office. 3. Scope – What Does This Policy Cover?

This Privacy Policy applies only to your use of Our Site and information you provide to Our members of staff. It does not extend to any websites that are linked from Our Site (whether We provide those links or whether they are shared by other users). We have no control over how your data is collected, stored or used by other websites and We advise you to check the privacy policies of any such websites before providing any data to them.

4. What Data Do We Collect?

Some data will be collected automatically by Our Site, other data will only be collected if you voluntarily submit it, for example, when signing up with Us or submitting your CV. Depending upon your use of Our Site, We may collect some or all of the following data:

- 4.1 name;
- 4.2 date of birth;
- 4.3 gender;
- 4.4 business/company name;
- 4.5 job title/profession;
- 4.6 results from any psychometric testing you undertake, either as part of a specific application process or for general applications;
- 4.7 contact information such as email addresses and telephone numbers;
- 4.8 demographic information such as post code, preferences and interests;
- 4.9 IP address (automatically collected); web browser type and version (automatically collected); operating system (automatically collected);



the pages of Our website that you visit, and the time spent on those pages; the time and date of your visit to Our website.

5 How Do We Use Your Data?

- 5.1 All personal data is stored securely in accordance with the principles of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). For more details on security see section 7, below.
- 5.2 We use your data to provide the best possible services to you. This includes:
 - 5.2.1 Providing our services to you;
 - 5.2.2 Providing and managing any account you may have with us;
 - 5.2.3 Providing and managing your access to Our Site;
 - 5.2.4 Enabling you to submit your CV for general applications or to apply for specific jobs or subscribe to our job alerts (for more details on CV's see section 6, below);
 - 5.2.5 Personalising and tailoring Our services for you, matching applicant details with job vacancies to assist us in finding a position that is most suitable for you;
 - 5.2.6 Responding to communications from you;
 - 5.2.7 Supplying you with email newsletters and alerts that you have subscribed to;
 - 5.2.8 Market research;
 - 5.2.9 Analysing your use of Our Site and gathering feedback to enable Us to continually improve Our Site and your user experience.
- 5.3 With your permission and/or where permitted by law, We may also use your data for marketing purposes which may include contacting you by email and telephone with information, news and offers on Our services. We will not, however, send you any unsolicited marketing or spam and will take all reasonable steps to ensure that We fully protect your rights and comply with Our obligations under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003, as amended in 2004, 2011 and 2015.

6 CV Submissions

- 6.1 You can submit your CV via our website or by providing your CV to a member of staff at Ezek Consulting Limited, either as a general application to be considered by Us when appropriate positions are available or to apply for a specific job;
- 6.2 You can update your CV at any time, by following the same online procedure as when you submitted your initial CV or by contacting a member of staff at Ezek Consulting Limited;
- 6.3 We will only send your CV to our clients with your prior consent. If you have made a general application and We feel a role may be appropriate for you, We will contact you before sending any information to the prospective employer.

7 How and Where Do We Store Your Data?

- 7.1 We only keep your data for as long as We need to in order to use it as described above in section 5, and/or for as long as We have your permission to keep it.
- 7.2 Your data will only be stored within the European Economic Area ("the EEA") (The EEA consists of all EU member states, plus Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein). You are deemed to accept and agree to this by using Our Site and submitting information to Us. If We do store or transfer data outside the EEA, We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data is treated as safely and securely as it would be within the EEA and under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Such steps may include, but not be



- limited to, the use of legally binding contractual terms between Us and any third parties We engage and the use of the EU-approved Model Contractual Arrangements.
- 7.3 Data security is of great importance to Us, and to protect your data We have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure data collected through Our Site.
- 7.4 Notwithstanding the security measures that We take, it is important to remember that the transmission of data via the internet may not be completely secure and that you are advised to take suitable precautions when transmitting to Us data via the internet.

8 Do We Share Your Data?

- 8.1 We may share your data with other companies in Our group.
- 8.2 We may sometimes contract with third parties to supply products and services to you on Our behalf. These may include payment processing, delivery of goods, search engine facilities, advertising and marketing. In some cases, the third parties may require access to some or all of your data. Where any of your data is required for such a purpose, We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data will be handled safely, securely, and in accordance with your rights, Our obligations, and the obligations of the third party under the law.
- 8.3 We may compile statistics about the use of Our Site including data on traffic, usage patterns, user numbers, sales and other information. All such data will be anonymised and will not include any personally identifying information. We may from time to time share such data with third parties such as prospective investors, affiliates, partners and advertisers. Data will only be shared and used within the bounds of the law.
- 8.4 In certain circumstances, We may be legally required to share certain data held by Us, which may include your personal information, for example, where We are involved in legal proceedings, where We are complying with the requirements of legislation, a court order, or a governmental authority. We do not require any further consent from you in order to share your data in such circumstances and will comply as required with any legally binding request that is made of Us.

9 What Happens If Our Business Changes Hands?

- 9.1 We may, from time to time, expand or reduce Our business and this may involve the sale and/or the transfer of control of all or part of Our business. Data provided by users will, where it is relevant to any part of Our business so transferred, be transferred along with that part and the new owner or newly controlling party will, under the terms of this Privacy Policy, be permitted to use the data for the purposes for which it was originally collected by Us.
- 9.2 In the event that any of your data is to be transferred in such a manner, you will not be contacted in advance and informed of the changes.

10 How Can You Control Your Data?

When you submit information via Our Site, you may be given options to restrict Our use of your data. In particular, We aim to give you strong controls on Our use of your data for direct marketing purposes (including the ability to opt-out of receiving emails from Us which you may do by unsubscribing using the links provided in Our emails).

11 Your Right to Withhold Information



- 11.1 You may access Our Site without providing any data at all. However, to use all features and functions available on Our Site you may be required to submit or allow for the collection of certain data.
- 11.2 You may restrict your internet browser's use of Cookies. For more information see section 12, below.
